Winter Boat Storage Policy and Fees

August 7, 2018

Dear Sandwich Marina Winter Storage Tenant:

The summer is drawing to a close and the winter storage season is fast approaching. We hope you enjoyed your boating season and look forward to having you store with us again this winter.

The following group haul out dates have been pre-scheduled with haulers. However, you may schedule alternate dates if desired.

Enclosed is your lease agreement for this year. Please review and return the signed lease with payment to the Sandwich Marina office by September 1, 2018.

The fee for winter storage is \$25.00 per foot. **All payments are non-refundable.**

- Payment and lease must be received by Sandwich Marina by September 1st 2018
- Payment received after September 1, 2018 will be assessed a late fee of \$20.00.
- Non-receipt of payment by September 15, 2018 will result in the loss of winter storage and their space will be reassigned.
- Boats will not be hauled out unless payment has been made in full with a signed lease and proof of insurance.

Customers storing a sailboat for the winter must pay by personal check, or money order.

You may arrange for any hauling company to haul your boat on or after *September 16, 2018*, you must notify the Marina office with date and time.

EPA regulations strictly prohibit boat owners from washing the bottom of their boats in the parking lots. Pressure washing is included in the storage fee and will be performed by the marina staff on the appropriate wash down pad. Pressure washing is available by appointment only Monday through Friday until 3 pm and must be confirmed with office staff. No pressure washing is performed on Sundays.

Please call the office to make an appointment. Pressure washing will not be available for tenants who haul their boats after October 31, 2018.

One night of free dockage before haul out is based strictly on space availability, and is granted on a first-come, first-serve basis. It is not guaranteed and electricity is additional. Any subsequent nights will be at the current transient rate of \$2.75/foot until October 15th and \$1.50/foot thereafter. Electricity is available for an additional fee.

The water will remain on in the parking lots as long as possible, weather permitting, but may be shut off without notice. Electricity and water will be turned off every day at 6:00p.m.until October 31st. You must be on your boat while plugged into electricity.

Pump-outs are available at the fuel dock or with pump-out boat prior to haul-out.

All winter storage customers are reminded to remove all valuables from the vessel during the storage season. It is recommended that you inspect your boat and stands, especially after winter storms and excessive wind. If you experience a problem with your boat stands, please contact your hauling company for details regarding potential adjustment.

To help expedite the hauling schedule please assure your boat is prepared for haul-out and arrive a minimum of one hour prior to your scheduled haul time and monitor CH 8 on your VHF. Do not go to the ramp until you are called. If you are not ready you may be passed over and have to wait.

Storage spaces will be assigned at the discretion of the Harbormaster.
